Dear Parents,

I hope that despite the challenges the COVID-19 has brought to our community that the spring break with family and friends has been enjoyable. Since my previous communication with you last Friday, much has changed. We need to remember and pray for many in our community who are bearing hardship as a result of closed businesses and the threat of illness.

Governor Evers announced this week that all schools are now closed **indefinitely**. This replaces the original return to school date of April 6. All co-curricular activities are also suspended indefinitely.

We have been working all week on a plan to provide for the education of our students. Next Wednesday, March 25, we will launch the details of how our online learning program will work. Students will go online using their RLHS email address and find resources, assignments, quizzes, tests and projects they will need to complete. We also have a process for communicating with their teachers. Most students already have taken home textbooks and materials they will need. For students who still have materials at RLHS, we will announce next week the process for students to get those materials. This process will allow a limited number of students in our building per Governor Evers' mandated 10-person rule.

This will be a new experience for many of our students. Therefore, I ask for your help as a parent, to ensure that your son or daughter logs in each day at the appropriate time, to communicate with his/her teachers and complete the required tasks.

I appreciate your patience and support as we navigate this unprecedented situation. As things change, which they seem to do every day, I will keep you informed.
