**\*PARENTS** – Please continue to monitor your children for symptoms of illness and keep them home if they are not feeling well. Students should remain home while they are awaiting COVID test results.

\*Please note the dates of **upcoming statewide standardized testing**.

**Friday, April 22--Freshmen take the ACT Aspire at RLHS.** Grades 10, 11, and 12 will attend virtually that day.

**Monday, April 25--Sophomores take the Wisconsin Forward Exam.** All students will attend in person that day.

Normal bus service will be provided for students who are testing. Students are dismissed once testing is completed. Please avoid making appointments or doing pre-planned absences if your child is testing on these dates.

**\*Seniors – Prom is Saturday, May 21, from 6 p.m. until midnight.** Tickets will be sold by the Rotary online starting Tuesday, April 19, and ending Friday, May 6. This is a hard-stop deadline, and we cannot do anything for students who do not buy their tickets on time. Tickets will cost \$50 per person plus an online purchase fee of \$3 or \$4. The motorcade to the Racine County Fairgrounds will begin at Roma Lodge no later than 6:10 p.m. Arrival time is slated for 7 p.m. More details will be shared in the near future.

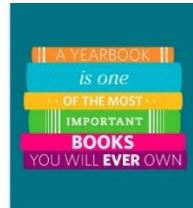

## **News from the Guidance Office**

\***The EAA** has launched an initiative to encourage **aviation pilots and mechanics** at the high school level. They have developed scholarships for students toward securing a private pilot’s license and for tuition to study aviation mechanics. The local EAA chapter is at Racine’s Batten Airport. \***Selective Service Registration** – Young men from the age of 18 through the age of 25 are required to complete the Selective Service Registration. The Selective Service System is designed to provide manpower to the Department of Defense in the event that a draft is required. Fortunately, this has not been the case for 50 years. Registration with Selective Service is required by law and failure to register will result in the loss benefits, including the ability to hold a federal or a state job and may impact a young man’s eligibility for federal student aid. Registration is quick and easy and can be found at [sss.gov](https://sss.gov).
