*St. Catherine's, Martin Luther, and St. Thomas More have changed their ticket policy to online ticketing. Each school will be using Ticket Spicket. You can search each school at this link https://events.ticketspicket.com/home

Here are the Guidelines for the Boys Basketball Game at Martin Luther on Tuesday.

Home Game Ticket Purchasing for basketball, football, volleyball, track and all WIAA tournament events:

- 1. All tickets must be purchased online. We will no longer accept cash at any of our home athletic events for ticket sales. Tickets can be purchased at http://spicket.events/martinluther.
- 2. Tickets will go on sale 1 week before each event start date.
- 3. When arriving at the event your ticket will be scanned. You can either show us your ticket on your cellular device to be scanned, or you can print your tickets at home to hand in and be scanned.
- 4. For all games, ticket sales will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the varsity game the day of the event. (This is subject to change for larger events and will be communicated ahead of time).
- 5. Gates will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the game for all home events. Any individual not in the event 30 minutes after the schedule start time of the game, will not be allowed to enter whether they have purchased a ticket or not.
- 6. Refunds will only be issued for canceled events that will not be rescheduled. No refunds will be given for any other reason.
- 7. There will be no re-entry upon exiting the event. Once an individual leaves, they will not be allowed back into the event.
- 8. All middle/elementary school students must be accompanied by an adult. Any middle/elementary students not accompanied by an adult will not be allowed into the game. The cost of an elementary/middle school ticket is \$2 and must be purchased online.
- 9. Passes
 - 1. Metro Classic Conference, Midwest Classic Conference, Woodland, and Capital North for Football ONLY.
 - 2. Metro Classic Conference ONLY for girls' volleyball, basketball and track are still allowed at the gate, a digital ticket is not required.
 - 3. ML Season Adult and Family passes, ML alumni passes, special youth night passes and LHSAGM passes are still allowed at the game, a digital ticket is not required.
- 10. Children 6 and under are free with an adult, no ticket is required for the child.

Here are the Guidelines for the Girls Basketball Game at St. Thomas More on <u>Saturday</u>. Note that <u>students will need a student ID</u>, and they must be a student from Racine Lutheran. Otherwise, they will need to purchase an adult ticket.

- 3) Sign up! It's Easy you will NOT need to register an account or keep a password on SignUp.com. Note: SignUp.com does not share your email address with anyone. If you prefer not to use your email address, please contact me and I can sign you up manually.
- *Racine Lutheran High School is on the NFHS Network! All home basketball games will now be livestreamed for anyone to view. Many of our away games are webcast on this platform as well. If you can't make it to the game, or if you have out of town relatives who want to watch, go to https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/ and search Racine Lutheran High School. A subscription is required.

*Please be aware of the following WIAA/Local Covid guarantine rules.

If a student/athlete has a confirmed positive case of Covid, he/she will quarantine for 5 days from the onset of symptoms. They may leave isolation after they have been fever free for 24 hours or longer and symptoms are generally improving.

If a student/athlete is determined to be a close contact with a confirmed positive case of Covid, he/she will: monitor for symptoms. If symptoms start, he/she should isolate and get tested. Quarantining is no longer required.

 Hours are 2 until 10 p.m. with the possibility of moving to a day position in the future.



You can order securely ONLINE on our school website.

Go to your JMC Parent portal.

- Select **Tuition/Fees** on the left, then **Purchase Items** in the blue box at the top.
- You can then **choose Yearbook** to place your order. You are not able to make purchases from a phone, so you must login using a computer.

The cost of the yearbook is **\$60**. Please order soon. Yearbooks arrive at the end of the school year, but we need to give the publisher our final number of books.

IMPORTANT SENIOR PICTURE INFO TO: SENIORS and PARENTS of the Class of 2023

Senior year is one of the most memorable years in a person's life and one involving many important decisions. One lasting memory of this year is the senior class portrait. **Now is the time to make arrangements for senior pictures if you have not already done so.** Traditionally, these photos are taken early in senior year, so that by January 1 everyone has chosen proofs and has the pictures back to exchange with friends and put in the yearbook.

For our yearbook, one **color** wallet-size print or digital file (approximately 2" wide x 3" high or larger) is needed **by** <u>MARCH 1</u>. Your photographer should send these to RLHS at no charge, or you can bring the photo in yourself. OR... You (or the photographer) also may submit a digital picture on a flash drive, or email it (<u>as an attachment</u> not an inline photo) to <u>iporter@racinelutheran.org</u> or <u>dmenk@racinelutheran.org</u>. Make sure digital pictures are high-resolution, <u>at least 300 dpi</u>.

You have many options. You may choose a professional photography studio or a family photographer, whatever you like best. There is a wide range of prices, picture quality, number of poses, changes of outfits, different settings, and other services. The cost will vary greatly for the senior-special packages, so compare, look at the samples on display and online, and ask a lot of questions.

Look at past yearbooks and write down the ideas you like best, otherwise you'll forget what you liked! *Consider:* indoors/outdoors, what to wear, which backgrounds, clear or shadowy or fuzzy focus, different poses, casual with your dog or more formal with a tie? *(No sideways, no horizontal pictures or full body standing head-to-feet shots can be used in the yearbook.* No very low-cut, revealing tops for the ladies.) You might want props like a pet, car, or soccer ball. Beware of wearing clothes too trendy or loud, because this picture may hang on the wall in your home for many years, and some fashions look pretty silly after they go out of style. These are just a few points to consider. The photographer will have lots more tips for you. It is a really good idea to have at least one pose taken in which you are a little more dressed-up; more formal looks are back in, and when seniors are asked to submit photos for applications or announcements, it's good to have a more sophisticated look to submit. It's up to you. Casual is fine, too.

The choices are yours, and the responsibility of having your picture taken is yours, too. If you have questions, please call or text Julie Porter at 262-498-5919 or email *iporter@racinelutheran.org*.

If you are <u>not</u> going to have a senior portrait done, please let us know, and we will make other arrangements or use the school ID picture taken this fall so that every senior is included in the 2023 yearbook. Thanks for your cooperation.

Also needed for the 2023 Yearbook...DEADLINE IS COMING!



By <u>February 1</u>, every senior needs to submit **baby, childhood**, **and casual** pictures for his/her page in the senior section.

- You may submit from 3 to 8 pictures (any size we can resize).
- We would like at least one baby/toddler picture, at least one childhood picture, and at least one candid picture. (The candid could be you with friends, family, pet, in a sport, on vacation, etc.)
- These pictures will be scanned, and the original photos will be returned to you quickly (usually within a week) and unharmed.
- You may also choose to scan your own pictures and submit the digital JPEG files on a flash drive or email them to dmenk@RacineLutheran.org or jporter@RacineLutheran.org or text to Mrs. Porter at 262-498-5919. If you scan your own, set the resolution to 300 dpi. If you send photos by email, please-send-them-as-ATTACHMENTS. First open your email, click the attachment icon, then select your photo files and send them as attachments. If you email through your phone, choose the largest file size (highest resolution).
- Please do <u>not</u> turn in computer printouts of pictures or photocopies-- they will be blurry when scanned and reprinted. <u>Send the original digital file rather than a print</u> unless it is a VERY high-quality print.
- Please label your pictures on the back (use permanent marker or pencil, <u>no ballpoint ink</u> since it smudges permanently onto your pictures). Turn them in to the school office in an envelope or plastic bag, also labeled with your name.
- You will have an opportunity to make changes before the final pages are sent to the publisher -- *if* you turn in your photos on time.
