The cast of "06/08" debuts at Racine Lutheran High School, 251 Luedtke Avenue, on Friday, April 28, at 7 p.m. The show also runs on Saturday, April 29, at 6 p.m., Sunday, April 30, at 2 p.m., Friday, May 5, at 7 p.m. and Saturday, May 6, at 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. Doors open one hour before the performance.
