- Prom is Saturday, May 20, at the County Fair Grounds in Union Grove.
- Tickets are \$50 + a \$5.20 fee on Eventbrite. Ticket prices are determined by the Rotary Club; our school receives no part of ticket revenues.
- It is listed as a “private” sale on Eventbrite, so it is not available through a general online search.
