***Seniors and Parents of Seniors** – There will be an informational meeting about **Senior Leadership Retreat** in the gym on **Monday, July 31, at 6 p.m.** Every senior should plan to attend with a parent/guardian. Make sure you've also added Senior Leadership Retreat to your calendar for Sunday, August 27, and Monday, August 28. ***Parking pass procedure for 2023-24** – Students parking in the school parking lot from 6:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. on school days must purchase a parking permit from the school office at a rate of \$100 for the entire school year. The entire row of parking closest to the building is designated as staff parking.

Due to our limited amount of parking spaces for students, the following procedure will be put into place to purchase a parking pass:

- To apply for a parking pass, \$100 must be received in the school office by 8 a.m. on August 1, either by cash, check, or through JMC.
- Names of all students who have paid the fee will be randomly drawn on August 1 for the available spots in the lot.
- All those who applied for a spot will be notified. Those who were selected must then fill out a car registration form, turn it into the office, and pick up their parking pass prior to the first day of school.
- Those who were not selected may either choose to have their money refunded or applied to another school fee during the year.

***Lunch Balances** – If you have received an invoice about owing a lunch balance from this past year, please pay it promptly. Please be aware that families are notified through JMC every time their lunch balance becomes negative. Our new policy will be that students who owe a lunch balance of \$25 or more will have their account locked in the lunchroom and will be unable to purchase food items at school.

***Missing/Damaged Textbooks and Locks** – If you received an invoice about a missing or damaged textbook or lock, please return the item or pay the fee promptly. Missing lock = \$10, Damaged book = \$20, Missing novel = \$20, Missing textbook = \$100. You may also check JMC to see if you have a balance.

***YEARBOOKS** – The 2023 RLHS yearbooks are delivered in summer. We include graduation, prom, and spring sports in our book, so it is not finished until the year ends. All the pages have been submitted to the publisher, so we hope the books will be finished in July. You will be contacted when the yearbooks are ready to be picked up.

***RLHS Volunteer/Family Service Hours** – Every family is expected to volunteer at least 20 hours of service each school year (July 1-June 30) to directly benefit RLHS. We ask that six of those hours are spent volunteering at our Thrift Shop. The Thrift Shop is open Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays and is looking for help during morning shifts (10 a.m.-1 p.m.) and afternoon shifts (1 p.m.-4 p.m.). Students, parents, grandparents, and friends of RLHS are needed to sort, clean, price and display merchandise and work in the store. One adult and one student, or two adults, are needed for each shift. **SATURDAY VOLUNTEERS ARE ESPECIALLY NEEDED!**

In addition to the Thrift Shop, there are many volunteer opportunities available including athletic events (concessions, gate, stats, football chain gang), theatre productions (tickets, concessions), Golf Outing, Harvest Fair, and Grand Gala. We are grateful for your service.

PLEASE NOTE: RLHS student responsibilities, commitments, and expectations that are part of a sport or club (NHS, Student Council, Student Ambassadors, team events) do not count toward the 20 RLHS service hours.

***Fall Sports Parents Meeting** for FOOTBALL, GIRLS VOLLEYBALL, BOYS SOCCER, CROSS COUNTRY – The fall sports meeting will be held at **7 p.m. on Monday, July 31**, in the RLHS gym.

***Fall Sports Parents Meeting** for BOYS VOLLEYBALL and GIRLS TENNIS – The fall sports meeting for Boys Volleyball and Girls Tennis will be held at St. Catherine's High School with the time and date to be announced soon.

***Participation requirements** – Summer is the best time to get physicals for the coming school year. Athletes cannot begin participation in fall practices until students are registered for their sport. To get a registration card, all the following must be turned in to the Athletic Office:

- 1) A physical exam is required of all student-athletes for the first and third year of high school participation.
OR
- 1a) An alternate year card is required of all student-athletes for the second and fourth year of high school participation.
- 2) Sign and return the Lutheran High Athletics Agreement and the Concussion Information and Acknowledgement Form which includes the Lutheran High Athletics Policies, WIAA Policies, the Metro Classic Conference Sportsmanship guidelines, the Ascension All Saints Athletic Training Consent for Care and Treatment, and student/parent concussion information. Please read the Athletic Handbook prior to signing this form.
- 3) Pay Participation Fee – These fees are used to offset some of the cost for transportation, officials, and equipment. The participation fee is \$150 per season with a cap of \$450 per year for a family (Boys volleyball and girls tennis co-op: \$200 made out to St. Catherine's). This fee does not cover the cost of hats, socks, etc.

All forms need to be turned in once per school year. These forms can be picked up at school or found online [here](#) on the school website.

AGAIN, PLAYERS MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN PRACTICE UNTIL ALL FORMS AND FEES HAVE BEEN TURNED IN TO THE ATHLETIC OFFICE.
