

Financial Aid Application

Racine Lutheran High School partners with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to help families in need. Through your online application, FACTS will analyze your financial information and estimate your family's ability to pay school costs based on your income, expenses, and family assets. The process is fair and confidential.

Application steps:

- 1. Complete your taxes.
- 2. Complete the online application at *https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3ZYTC* with a nominal credit card payment made directly to FACTS.
- 3. Send all necessary supporting documentation to:

- Copies of your most recent tax forms, including all supporting tax schedules.
- $\circ~$ A copy of all W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

If a student's parents are separated or divorced, Racine Lutheran High School requires both parents to submit a separate application and include financial information from each parent's spouse, if remarried.

Once the process is complete, the school will send a letter to each applicant regarding their financial aid award. Funds are limited.
